


Reserves Day 2024

What is Reserves Day?

Reserves Day provides an opportunity for the country to recognise our Reserve Forces.

This year Reserves Day will take place on 26 June 2024.

Reservists give up their spare time to serve in the Reserve Forces, balancing their civilian life with a military career to ensure that should their country require them, they would be ready to serve as part of the military.

The Reserve Forces make up approximately one sixth of our Armed Forces personnel and are integral to protecting the nation's security at home and overseas, particularly providing capability in specialist areas such as medical and cyber.

Reservists are currently supporting operations in the UK and overseas.

Reserves Day was created to highlight and recognise the valuable contribution Reservists make to our Armed Forces.



How can I show support as an employer?

There are many ways that your organisation can support on Reserves Day:

- Join in with the digital campaign using the **#ReservesDay** and **#SaluteOurForces** hashtags to show your support on social media.
- Use the Digital Toolkit available on the Armed Forces Day website to show your support on your internal and social media channels
- Ask your reservists to share their thoughts on life as a reservist for internal and external communications such as intranet articles, blogs, videos or social media posts using the hashtags.
- Host an internal event such as a lunch or tea for your reservists and colleagues, for example a lunch and learn where staff can find out more about life as reservist. Post images of the event on social media using the hashtags.
- Encourage any reservists in your team to come in wearing uniform (if appropriate and safe to do so). Post images of them in their civilian role on social media using the hashtags




Reserves Day Digital Assets

- The Reservist community is diverse. Reservists come from all parts of society and all walks of life.
- Joining the Reserves gives you an opportunity to enjoy a range of extraordinary new experiences and to develop new skills you would not get in your day-to-day life.
